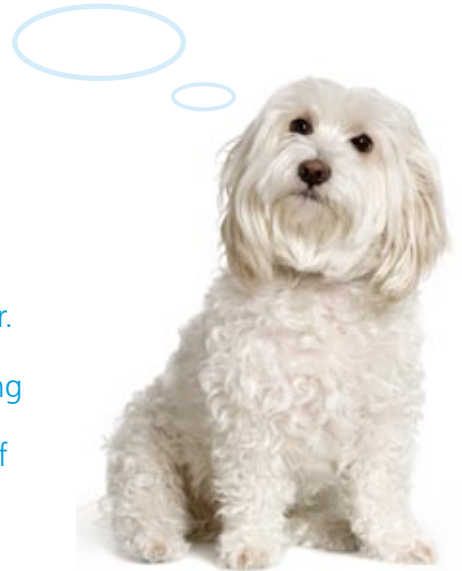

She has a background in natural therapies and studied with various elders and shamans from different cultures, was initiated into the Seneca Wolf Clan Teaching Lodge by Grandmother Kitty, and adopted by a Maori tribe. She is also a member of the Order of Bards, Ovates and Druids.

Billie is also the first Australian to receive the Munay-Ki – the luminous codes for the new human, during her study with Inka Elders and shaman Alberto Villoldo, PhD.

Billie's path is one of connecting to the sacred, reawakening ancient gifts, lighting the path of the heart for a new humanity and treating all of life with reverence. She teaches in the old tradition of storytelling and practical experience.

With her husband, author and filmmaker Andrew Einspruch, Billie runs Ballyoncree Animal Sanctuary, a holistic forever home. Billie and Andrew are strong supporters of animal rights and are dedicated to promoting ethics, integrity, compassion and commitment in humans working for and living with animals.
